Sant'Erasmo	Island north-east of the historic city, interesting for its market gardening, some farms can be visited to sample local produce
Lazzaretto Nuovo	Small island next to Sant'Erasmo island, with historical, archaeological, and natural features and exhibits (was once a location used to quarantine ships for prevention of

Lazzaretto Vecchio	Small island near the Lido, site of first hospital in the world to treat plague-infected

Mazzorbo	Small island next to Burano, interesting for its agriculture and wine making (Venissa

San Francesco del	Small island near Sant'Erasmo island with Franciscan church and convent

Torcello	Small island in the northern lagoon, important for its history, archaeology, and basilica. The bell tower of the basilica offers panoramic views over the northern lagoon (ticketed) <a href="https://www.isoladiburano.it/en/torcello.html">https://www.isoladiburano.it/en/torcello.html</a> The boat journey to Torcello also offers opportunity to appreciate the lagoon environment
Boat tour of northern lagoon	Many islands in the northern lagoon can be accessed using the vaporetto (water bus) service, but possible to book bespoke group trips with some companies, (e.g. El Bragosso Va). MOSE mobile barrier scheme can be seen at the San Nicolò inlet, 'valle da pesca' (a system of fish farming) is an economic activity that can be seen in parts of the lagoon
