<u>START</u>	EPIDEMIC	Number of deaths per 1000/year	PANDEMIC
An epidemic occurring over a widespread area (multiple countries or continents)	PARASITE	The outbreak of an infectious disease.	LIFE EXPECTANCY
A carrier, such as a mosquito, that transmits a disease or infection from one person to another.	BACTERIA	An infective agent that typically is able to multiply only within the living cells of a host.	INFECTIOUS DISEASE
An organism which lives in or on another organism (its host) and benefits by deriving nutrients at the other's expense.	VECTOR	The proportion of a population who experience an acute health event during a limited period (e.g., during an outbreak).	INFANT MORTALITY RATE
A disease transmitted through direct contact with an infected individual (e.g. HIV/AIDS) or indirectly through a	CONTAGIOUS DIEASE	A member of a group of microorganisms which can cause disease.	EXOGENIC DISEASE
vector (e.g. malaria). The number of deaths of children aged <1 year, per 1,000 live births/year.	GLOBESITY	The sudden and widespread surge in weight levels rising from over nutrition and lack of exercise.	DEATH RATE



A disease related to internal processes within a person e.g. an immune disorder.	VIRUS	A statistical projection of the average number of years a person of a given age is expected to live.	ATTACK RATE
A disease related to environmental conditions.	ENDOGENIC DISEASE	Capable of being transmitted from one person to another by contact or close proximity.	<u>FINISH</u>
