This series of DVDs are a 'must have' for any department using Mumbai for GCSE or A level case studies.

The documentaries are easy to watch and simple to follow. Whilst aimed at students from year 7 to year 13, I found that they are most beneficial for my GCSE geographers. The DVD series provides an up-to-date look at the city of Mumbai, its development, challenges and management.

The series is in four DVDs:

- Urbanisation and megacities: Mumbai
- Inside Dharavi: Life in India's largest slum
- Mumbai: Managing a megacity
- Mumbai's slum redevelopment challenge

At around 30 minutes long the documentaries can be used as standalone lessons or (as I will be using them) embedded into a longer scheme of learning.

In addition to the documentary, each DVD is accompanied by a series of resources that guide students and teachers through the Mumbai case study. Just some of the resources included are: key word definitions, numeracy activities, photograph analysis and 8/9 mark question practice. All of these titles come with student guidance and relevant mark schemes suitable for the Edexcel, Eduqas, OCR and AQA specifications.

Overall, this is an extremely useful DVD series that teachers can use to complement their teaching on Mumbai.
